AUGUST MISSION PROJECT:

Louisiana Correctional Institute for Women

January: —Bar of Soap (4-5 oz. Size); no "specialty" soaps

February/March:—Toothbrush — adult size, individually wrapped in original, unbroken wrapper; only 1 toothbrush per wrapper

April/May:—Shampoo with Conditioner (2-in-1 combination) 15-20 oz. in plastic bottle

June /July:—Toothpaste (6-9 oz. size) ingredients must be listed and box says "made in the USA" (Toothpaste checked at Wal-Mart was all made in USA)

August/September:—Lotion (8-11 oz. size) in plastic bottle — no pump, tube, or "specialty" lotions such as Bath and Body Works

October:—White socks — new women's crew socks (no ankle or no-show socks)

November/December:—Solid or roll-on women's deodorant (2-3.5 oz.) in plastic bottle
